Term 2.2: Jobs, Vowel, number

Pupils will learn about different types of jobs in Punjabi.

- Recognise Punjabi vowels.
- Describe what jobs your family members do.
- Recognise Punjabi vowel.
- Say what jobs you would like to do in the future.
- Understand what jobs others would like to do in the future.

- How to describe his/her morning routine using the time.
- How to say when you get up and go to bed. Also understand when others get up and go to bed.

Term 2.2: Food and Eating Out

Pupils will be able to say what they eat, or drink and they will learn how to use past, present and future tenses appropriately in a sentence.

- Begin to learn to state preferences in relation to food.
- How to order food from a menu.

- Discuss advantages and disadvantages of technology.
- Evaluate attitudes and opinions to the use of technology.
- Design an app.

Term 2.2: Healthy Living

Pupils will be able to identify food items and they will spend time in exploring the importance of healthy eating and healthy living.

- Give opinions and justify them about healthy/unhealthy food.
- Offer advice to others on how to lead a healthy lifestyle.

Summer Term

Term 3.1: Health and Welfare, Vowels

- Recognise and say parts of body and face.
- Recognise Punjabi vowels.

Term 3.2: My Home, Vowels

Term 3.1: Shopping for Clothes/pocket money/friends

Pupils will learn about fashion and shopping.

- Describe what others wear using more detail (adjectives).
- Understand short passages on this topic such as adverts.

Term 3.1: School Life

Pupils will learn about school life in Punjabi.

- Describe your school day.
- Giving opinion on school uniform.
- Discuss advantages and disadvantages of school uniform.
- Know the facilities available in school.



Pupils will compare types of homes, rooms, and furniture.

- Recognise Punjabi vowels.
- Identify types of houses.
- Recognise Punjabi vowels.
- Use simple vocabulary to describe rooms in a house.
- List some house items.

- Discuss fashion trends.
- Describe what people do to earn pocket money.
- Discuss views and opinions about how people earn and spend their pocket money.

Term 3.2: Weather

Pupils will learn about four seasons and different types of weather.

- Know some weather phrases.
- Explore Punjab's weather.
- Design weather chart.
- Compare different weather.

Term 3.2: Special occasions/Religious festivalsPupils learn about different cultural and religious festivals celebrated in the UK and in the Punjab.

- Describe birthdays and family celebrations.
- Give an account of a marriage ceremony you have attended.
- Write invitations to a birthday party.
